Monday March 23, 2009

A meeting of the West Caln Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday March 23, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Martz, Price and Pfitzenmeyer, Solicitor Moskovitz, Police Chief Martinez, Treasurer Johnson, Road Foreman Touchton and Manager-Secretary Dunlap. There were 12 citizens in attendance.

Chairman Pfitzenmeyer opened the meeting and lead in the flag salute. The following business was then conducted.

1. Citizens Comments.

A. Mr. Robert Johnson inquired as to whether Yerkes Associates was still performing Building Inspections in the Township. He was advised by the Board that Yerkes is still performing inspections in the Calnshire Development and would continue to do so for the time being. Mr. Price further advised that Yerkes may also do future inspections if the Board deemed it necessary.

2. Subdivision Approval, J. Eric and Marjorie Byerly, W. King's Hwy., Lot Line Revision.

Mr. Martz moved to approve the plan as presented to the Board. Second, Mr. Price. Questions, none. Vote 3-0 in favor of approval.

3. Extension Request, Madanat Subdivision, Reid.

Mr. Price moved to accept a 180 day extension of time for review of the Madanat Subdivision in order for them to work out sewage issues. Second, Mr. Martz. Questions, none. Vote 3-0 in favor of the motion. The new deadline is September 25, 2009.

4. Solicitor Comments.

Mr. Moskovitz advised that he has been in contact with Dave Linahan on advertising the 537 Plan, and that he is taking appropriate action in collecting monies owed to the Township from Heritage Building Group and Pondsview, LLC.

5. Mr. Pfitzenmeyer announced that the West Caln Community Day has been changed to September 26, 2009.

6. Chief Martinez reported that for the month of February 2009, the Police Dept. worked a total of 985.5 hours, traveled 7802 miles, received 1235 complaints, investigated 11 accidents, and



made 32 arrests including, 21 traffic, 4 non traffic, 3 misdemeanor, 2 felony, 1 D.U.I. and 1 ordinance arrest. 38 warnings were issued. He asked that the Parks Bathrooms be opened up in time for the April 18, 2009 Sandy Hill Church 5K Run, the Dog Ordinance be put on the Township Website and that Turpin Brother's would be landscaping the flag pole area in front of the Administration Building.

7. Mr. Martz reported that Verizon has not repaired Brandywine Drive when FIOS was installed. Mr. Dunlap will contact Verizon on the matter.

With no further business at hand, adjournment was at 7:12 P.M.
