Monday November 16, 2009

A meeting of the West Caln Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday November 16, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Martz, Price, and Pfitzenmeyer, Police Chief Martinez, Treasurer Johnson, Ass't Manager Vaughn and Manager-Secretary Dunlap. There was one citizen present.

Chairman Pfitzenmeyer opened the meeting and lead in the salute to the flag. The following business was then conducted.

1. Citizen's Comments. None.
2. 2010 Budget.

Mr. Dunlap presented the 2010 Budget calling for receipts and expenditures in the amount of \$1,726,013.00. He reported that the Budget was revised after cuts were made in the Police and Road Dept. Budgets. After a discussion on the matter, the Board decided that \$86,000 cut from the Police Budget would remain, thus, bringing the Budget total to \$1,812,013.00. Mr. Pfitzenmeyer then moved to advertise the budget in accordance with the Township Code. Second, Mr. Martz. Questions, none. Vote 3-0 in favor of the motion.

3. New Business.

A. Mr. Pfitzenmeyer moved to advertise the sale of the old Police Car on the Municipal Bids Website and in the Daily Local News, reserving the right to reject any or all bids. Second, Mr. Martz. Questions, none. Vote 3-0 in favor of the motion.

B. Mr. Dunlap presented a Service Contract from Winter Engine for yearly maintenance on the generator for the Administration Building. Cost, \$618.00. Mr. Pfitzenmeyer moved to approve the Contract. Second, Mr. Martz. Questions, none. Vote 3-0 in favor of the motion.

C. The Board decided that they will meet on December 7, 2009 unless announced otherwise.

D. Chief Martinez advised the that Solicitor Moskovitz is looking into an Agreement for Sgt. Fries and that he is looking into Verizon Cell Phones for the Township.

E. The Board set December 16, 2009 as a tentative date for a hearing for 1201 Airport Rd.


D. A discussion was held on possibly mailing the Newsletter once a year. The Board will look into putting it on the Township Website and distributing it in various locations throughout the Township.
