A meeting of the West Caln Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday March 22, 2010 at 7 P.M. in the Township Municipal Building. Chairman Pfitzenmeyer opened the meeting and lead in the salute to the flag. The following business was then conducted.

1. Citizen's comments. None.
2. Resoution 4-10. Hazards Mitigation. This was requested by Chester County DES.

Mr. Pfitzenmeyer moved to approve the resolution. Second, Mr. Martz. Questions, none. Vote 2-0 in favor of the motion.


3. David Glick Subdivision.

Mr. Dunlap advised the Board that Solicitor Moskowitz is still preparing documents for Mr. Glick and no response has been received from the DEP on the Planning Modules. He suggested that any action be tabled until the April 12, 2010 meeting. Mr. Pfitzenmeyer moved to table any action on the plan until April 12th and to ask Mr. Glick to grant an extension of time for plan review to the Board as his current extension runs out April 9, 2010. Second, Mr. Martz. Questions, none. Vote 2-0 in favor of the motion.

4. In other business, the Board unanimously approved a request from Police Chief Martinez to advance the Police Dept. \$20,000.00 obtain a Police K-9 and other equipment. Grants have been awarded for these items , but have not been received.

With no further business at hand, the adjournment was at 7:05 P.M.
